The middle school had a very successful trip to the Zoo last week made possible by the fantastic support from you all. The learning about animal habitats is greatly enhanced by experiencing the zoo habitats. They will be at school at various times during the week, talking to the BOT, staff and students about their learning and achievement and observing the process in classrooms.
