This week is Te Wiki o te Reo Maori. ‘Kia Kaha te Reo Māori’ We have been encouraging everyone to increase the level of Te Reo that they are using with a new phrase each day and by giving special pink tickets when we catch the reo being used! We have also had colouring in competitions and Matua Terry has included tītī torea (Maori stick games) in Kiwi can sessions. There are “Kowhaiwhai” bookmark templates and Te Reo puzzles in the library for students to complete during break times. As with any Maori celebration a kai hakiri signals the end of a celebration and so tomorrow, teachers and senior students are organizing a sausage sizzle at lunchtime for all the students and junior classes are providing a sweet treat. We will cater for those students who do not eat beef. This does not replace normal lunches and your child will still need to bring their usual snacks and lunch if they do not wish to have a sausage. Lunch orders will continue as usual.

This week is also Clean Up New Zealand Week and classes have been out into the community picking up rubbish. We hope that you will encourage them to keep Crawshaw clean and tidy firstly by not dropping rubbish and secondly by picking up rubbish if they see it and disposing of it appropriately.
